



ALL-FLORIDA ACADEMIC TEAM MEMBER SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

2019 ALL- FLORIDA ACADEMIC TEAM

AWARDED BY: FLORIDA A&M UNIVERSITY (FAMU)

A Phi Theta Kappa member will be awarded up to \$4,000 per year with a 3.50 – 4.00 GPA. This scholarship is renewable for up to three semesters.

- Admitted to FAMU by November 1 (spring) or May 14 (fall)
- 3.5 minimum transfer GPA
- A.A. degree from a Florida College System institution

Renewal requirements include, but not limited to:

- Enroll in a minimum of 15 credit hours each semester.
- Earn a “C” or better in all courses each semester. If you do not earn a “C” or better in each course, the scholarship will terminate.
- Earn a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or better at the end of each semester.
- Validated (*submission of verification documents*) and completed FAFSA on file in the FAMU Office of Financial prior to January 1.
- Loss of scholarship (*termination*) will not be reinstated at a later date.

AWARDED BY: FLORIDA ATLANTIC UNIVERSITY

Honors/Phi Theta Kappa (PTK) Scholarship: \$3,200 per year for incoming junior transfer students with a minimum 3.5 GPA. Eligible students are graduates of the Honors Program or members of the PTK chapter at a Florida College System institution. A letter of recommendation from an Honors or PTK advisor is required. This scholarship is renewable for up to five semesters.

All Transfer Students:

Awards \$500 in the fall semester once accepted into the program and \$1,500 in the spring once research is secured, available for undergraduate transfer students with a declared major in the following colleges: College of Science or College of Engineering and Computer Science. Eligibility criteria includes a minimum GPA of 3.0, transfer from another institution, previously awarded an A.A. or A.S. degree and submission of the program application. The scholarship is non-renewable.

AWARDED BY: FLORIDA GULF COAST UNIVERSITY (FGCU)

FGCU automatically awards the \$3,000 Eagle Transfer Gold Scholarship to students that meet the following requirements (no separate scholarship application required):

- Apply to FGCU by November 1 (spring) or May 1 (fall)
- 3.5 minimum transfer GPA
- A.A. degree from a Florida College System institution

Renewal requirements include:

- Maintain a 3.0 GPA
- Must successfully complete 30 hours within the first year
- Scholarship is renewable for up to four semesters only
- In addition, if students successfully complete one semester with FGCU in a STEM major, they will receive an additional \$500 (renewable for up to three semesters.)

FSU offers two scholarships of \$4,000 to students selected to the All-Florida Academic First Team. Recipients of the award are required to maintain a GPA of at least 3.0 and successfully complete 15 credit hours each semester of the award.

In order to qualify, applicants must have a minimum cumulative college GPA of 3.8. Deadline for applying is May 1. Recipients must enroll at FSU in the fall semester immediately upon earning an A.A. degree from a Florida College System institution.
